I felt compelled to write this letter in order to update you on what we've discovered since you made the first installation of the Energy Passive Groundwater Recharge Product (EGRP) here at Plum Brook in 2008.

My family has owned and operated Plum Brook Golf Club in Sterling Heights Michigan since 1927. Because of the lower terrain on Hole #3, it invariably flooded. About one and one-half acres of the valley was so saturated after a modest rainfall that we couldn't even get a lawnmower through the area. Many rounds of golf have been lost because of poor drainage on Hole #3 and certain other parts of the golf course.


When you approached us seven years ago looking for a test site for your groundbreaking water drainage technology, we had serious doubts that it could work. However, we accepted your handshake as a commitment to solve the problems we had.

Installation of the system was fast, non-intrusive and did not tear up any part of the golf course. As soon as you were done, play resumed as if you had never been here. With drainage tile, the course would have been torn up and much labor and expense would have been required to place it back into shape.

Now you've completed the various phases of your tests and I am very pleased with both the installation of the EGRP system and its performance. The ground has become much less saturated. We have been able to mow Hole #3 much more consistently even after heavy rainfall. Even more important, I am very excited there is no required maintenance on the system as it appears to be getting better and better with time.

Thank you very much for delivering on every aspect of your commitment. Your EGRP technology has solved an 80 year old problem at our family golf course and we are so happy to endorse it to resolve any water infiltration problem at golf courses or fields.
